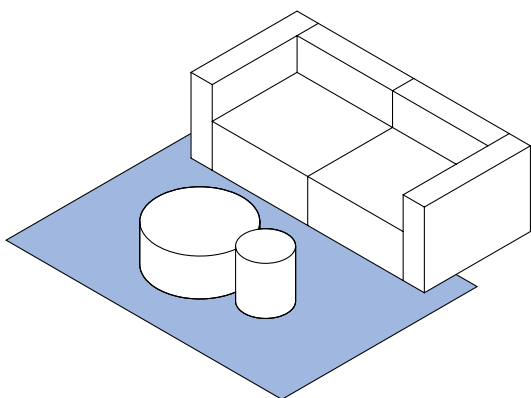
**Choosing the perfect rug for every room**

## INTRODUCTION

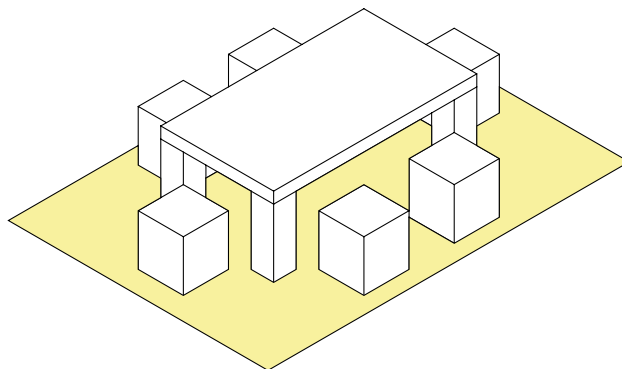
A rug is more than a finishing touch. It is an architectural element that defines the proportions of a room, anchors the furniture and shapes the way a space is experienced. For this reason, its size should ideally be considered from the very beginning of the design process, alongside the furniture layout.

Today, there is no single "right" or "wrong" way to place a rug. Every interior is different, but there are timeless layouts and proportions that create a balanced, harmonious space. This guide explores the most common rug sizes and placement options, helping you choose the solution that best suits your home.

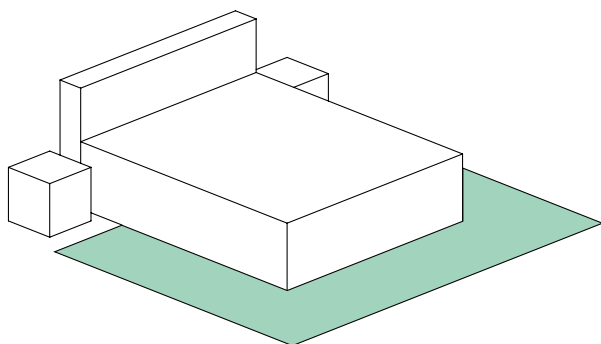
If your space is already furnished, a simple way to visualise the right size is to outline the rug's dimensions on the floor with masking tape. This allows you to test different proportions, understand how your furniture will sit on the rug and confidently imagine the scale of your future cc-tapis rug before making your choice.



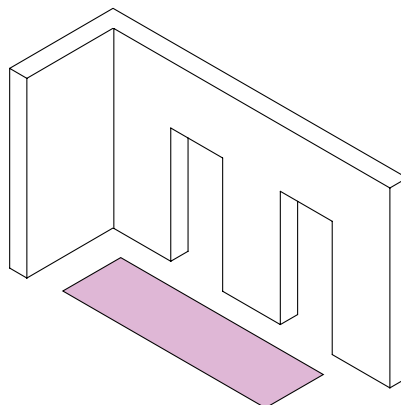
LIVING ROOM

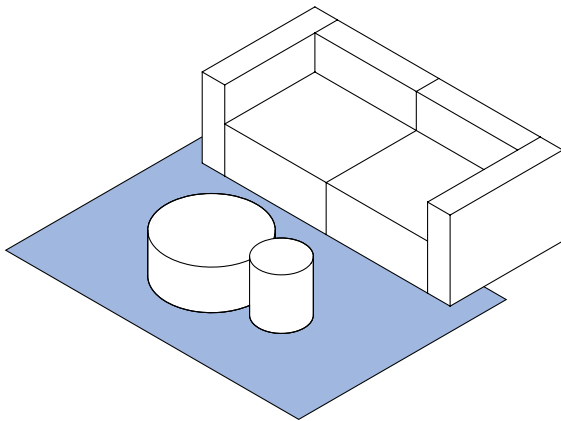

**LIVING ROOM**

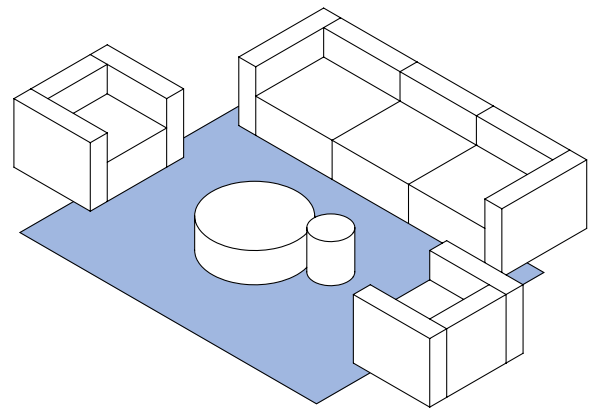
The living room is where a rug has the greatest visual impact. It should anchor the seating area and connect sofas, armchairs and coffee tables into one composition.

**COMPACT LAYOUT**

**Recommended rug size:**  
**170 × 240 cm**

**Ideal for compact living rooms or seating areas with a two-seater sofa.**

**Position the rug so that the front legs of the sofa and any armchairs rest on it, allowing the rug to extend approximately 10–30 cm beneath the seating. This layout visually connects the furniture while maintaining an open and well-balanced feel, making it particularly suitable for smaller spaces.**

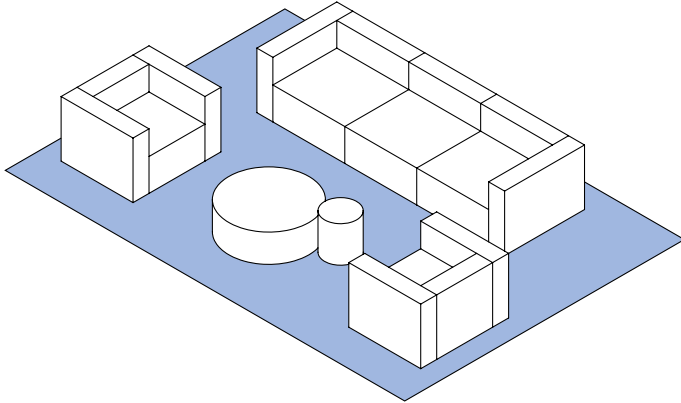
**EXTENDED LAYOUT**

**Recommended rug size:**  
**230 × 300 cm**

**Ideal for most living rooms with a two- or three-seater sofa.**

**Position the rug beneath the front legs of the sofa and any armchairs, allowing it to extend approximately 10–30 cm beneath the seating. Ideally, the rug should extend at least 20 cm beyond each side of the sofa, creating a balanced and well-proportioned composition. Armchairs can sit partially on the rug, helping to define a cohesive and inviting seating area.**

## ROOM LAYOUT

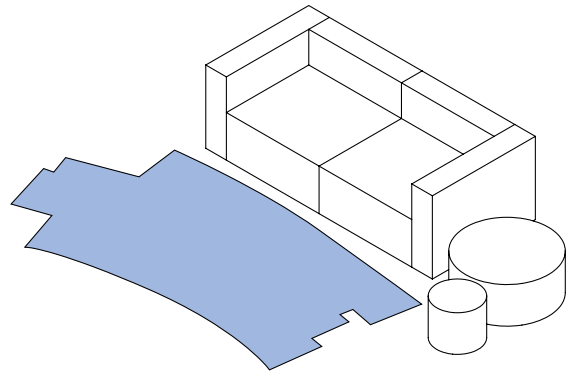


**Recommended rug size:**  
**300 × 400 cm or larger**

**Ideal for spacious living rooms with a three - or four-seater sofa, especially when the seating area is positioned in the centre of the room.**

**Place the entire seating arrangement on the rug, including the sofa and armchairs. Allow the rug to extend approximately 10–30 cm beyond the sofa at the back and at least 10–30 cm beyond the furniture on all sides, creating a generous frame around the composition. This layout enhances the sense of scale, defines the living area and brings a cohesive, architectural feel to larger spaces.**

## FREEFORM LAYOUT

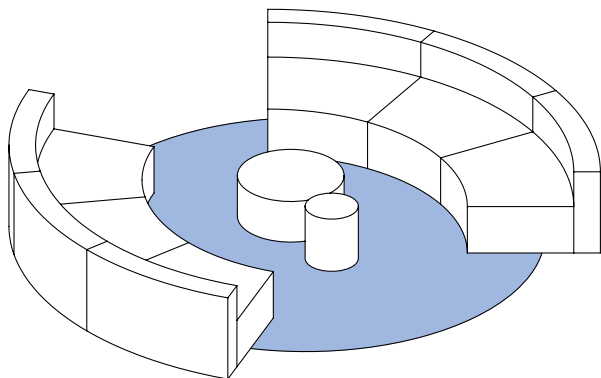


**Recommended rug size:**  
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**Ideal for living rooms with irregular, curved or statement furniture, such as organic sofas, sculptural armchairs or more unconventional seating compositions.**

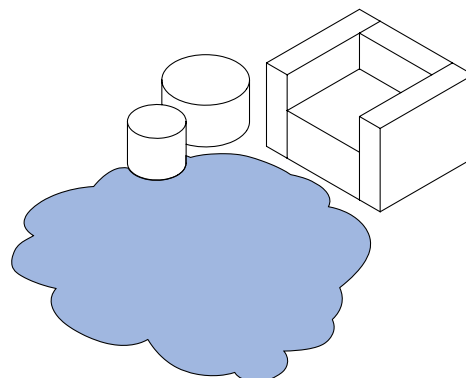
**Position the rug to follow and enhance the flow of the furniture, allowing its unique shape to interact with the surrounding elements. Rather than defining the space through traditional proportions, a freeform rug creates a more expressive composition, adding movement and character to the room.**

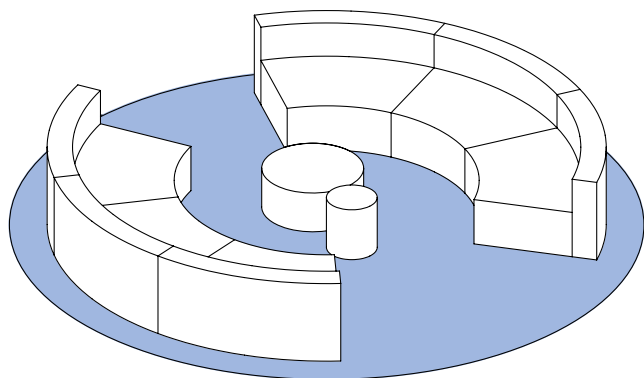

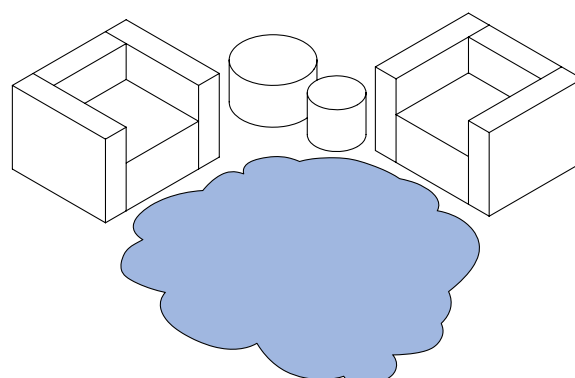

**Recommended rug size**  
**250 × 250 cm or larger**

Round rugs are particularly suited to living rooms with curved sofas, rounded furniture or facing seating arrangements.

Their soft geometry helps create a more fluid and intimate conversation area, breaking away from the linear structure of the room. Position the rug so that the seating elements overlap the edge of the rug by approximately 20 cm, allowing the furniture to visually connect with the centre of the composition.



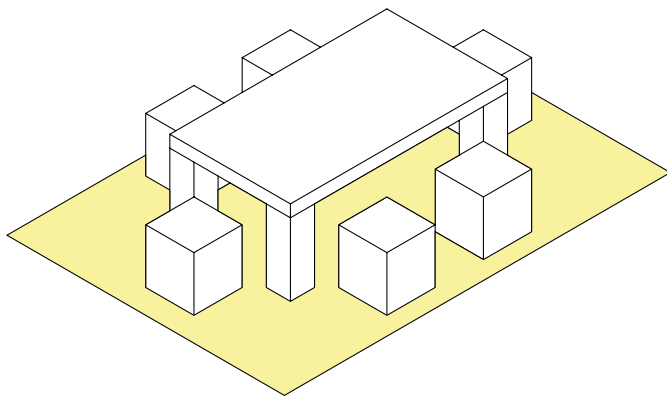

**Recommended rug size:**  
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Freeform rugs are designed to create softer, more sculptural compositions. Rather than framing the furniture, they can sit independently within the room, becoming a focal point in their own right.

**DINING ROOM**

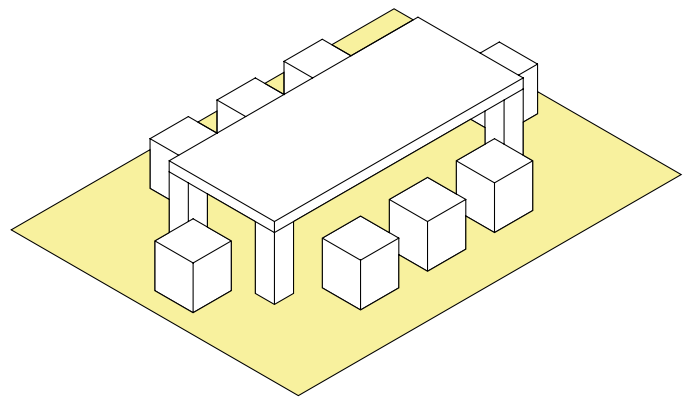
In the dining room, proportion is key. A rug should frame the dining set with generous clearance, allowing chairs to move freely while maintaining a balanced composition. As a general guideline, allow approximately 50–60 cm of additional rug space beyond the edge of the table on all sides, ensuring chairs remain comfortably on the rug when pulled out.

**CLASSIC COMPOSITION**

**Recommended rug size**  
**230 × 300 cm**

**Ideal for dining tables seating up to six people.**

The rug should extend beyond the table on all sides, providing enough space for chairs to remain fully on the rug when pulled out. This creates a more balanced and comfortable dining area, while visually defining the space around the table.

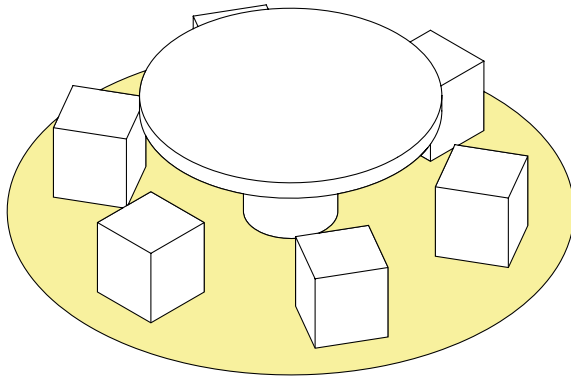
**GENEROUS COMPOSITION**

**Recommended rug size**  
**300 × 400 cm**

**Ideal for larger dining rooms and generous tables, including dining sets designed for six to eight people.**

Choose a rug that creates a wide frame around the entire dining composition, allowing the table and chairs to sit comfortably within the space. This layout helps define the dining area, creating a more balanced and cohesive setting while enhancing the sense of proportion in larger rooms.

## ROUND COMPOSITION



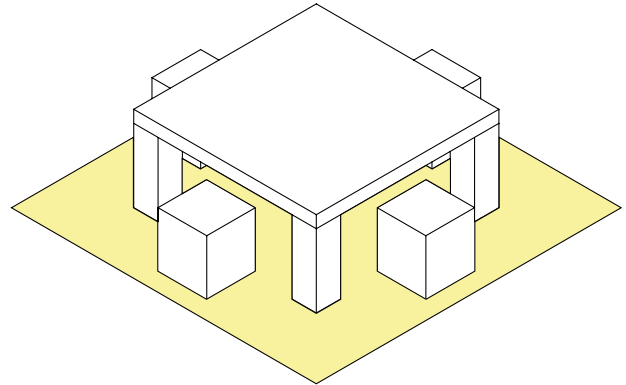
**Recommended rug size**  
**250 × 250 cm**  
**300 × 300 cm**

**Ideal for round dining tables seating four to eight people.**

**A 250 × 250 cm round rug is suitable for tables seating up to four people, typically with a diameter of approximately 120–130 cm. For larger round tables seating six to eight people, a 300 × 300 cm rug provides the right proportions for table diameters of approximately 140–150 cm.**

**Round rugs naturally complement circular tables, creating a softer and more harmonious dining composition. Their organic geometry helps define the dining area while maintaining a balanced relationship between the table, chairs and surrounding space.**

## SQUARE COMPOSITION



**Recommended rug size**  
**250 × 250 cm**  
**300 × 300 cm**

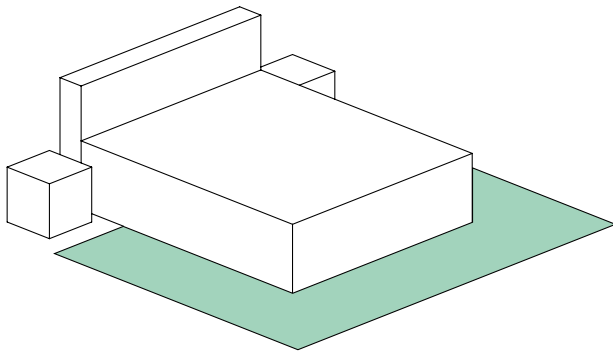
**Ideal for round dining tables seating four to eight people.**

**Square rugs naturally complement square dining tables, creating a balanced and symmetrical composition. A 250 × 250 cm rug is suitable for tables up to approximately 120 × 120 cm, while a 300 × 300 cm rug works well with larger tables of approximately 150 × 150 cm.**

**The defined geometry of a square rug helps frame the dining area and maintain a harmonious relationship between the table, chairs and surrounding space.**

**BEDROOM**

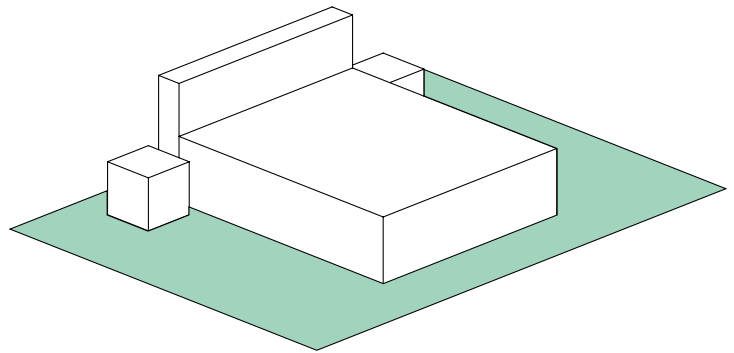
The bedroom is a space for comfort and relaxation. A well-proportioned rug adds warmth underfoot while creating a balanced composition around the bed.

**PARTIAL PLACEMENT**

**Recommended rug size**  
**230 × 300 cm**

**Ideal for standard-size double beds.**

Position the rug underneath the bed, starting just after the bedside tables and allowing it to extend approximately 50–60 cm beyond each side of the bed and 50–60 cm beyond the foot of the bed. This creates a soft and comfortable surface around the bed while maintaining balanced proportions within the room.

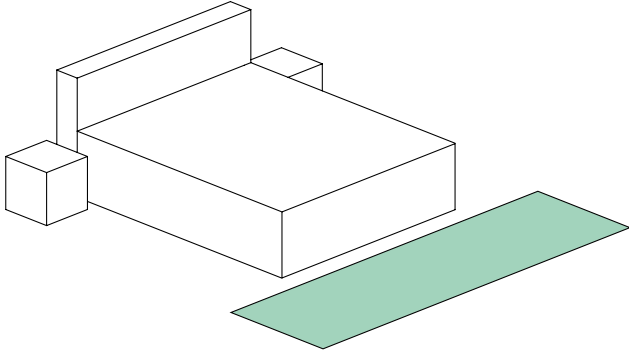
**FULL PLACEMENT**

**Recommended rug size**  
**300 × 400 cm**

**Ideal for standard or king-size beds positioned centrally within the room.**

Position the rug beneath the entire bed and bedside tables, allowing it to extend approximately 50–60 cm beyond all sides of the bed. This creates a generous frame around the sleeping area, visually anchoring the bed and defining the bedroom as a cohesive composition.

## RUNNER PLACEMENT

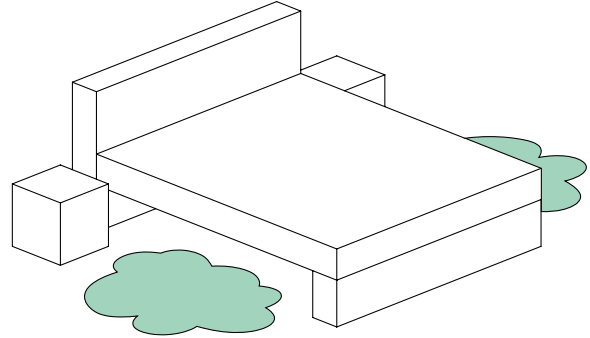


**Recommended rug size**  
**100 × 300 cm**

**Ideal for placing at the foot of standard double or king-size beds.**

A runner rug at the foot of the bed creates a soft and welcoming transition area while adding a decorative layer to the bedroom. Position it centrally in front of the bed, allowing it to extend across the width of the sleeping area and visually complete the composition. This layout is ideal when you want to introduce warmth and texture without covering the entire floor area, creating a balanced accent within the room.

## FREEFORM PLACEMENT



**Recommended rug size**

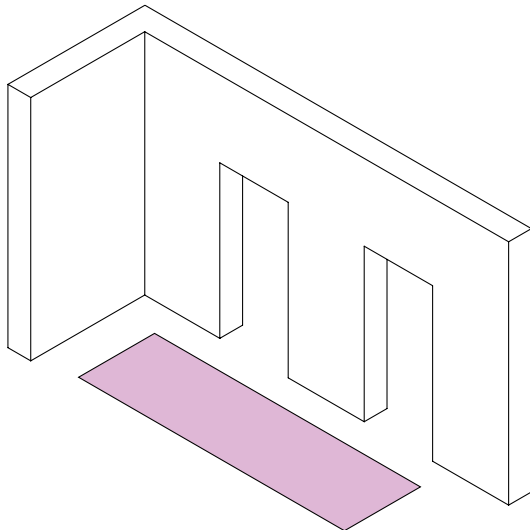
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**Ideal for bedside placement and sculptural interiors.**

Freeform rugs work beautifully alongside the bed, creating a softer alternative to traditional rectangular bedside rugs. Their organic shapes introduce movement and individuality, complementing curved furniture and more expressive bedroom compositions. Position the rug where it can be experienced underfoot when getting in and out of bed, allowing its unique silhouette to become part of the overall room composition.

**HALLWAY**

**Runner rugs bring warmth to transitional spaces and visually elongate the corridor.**

**LINEAR FRAME**

**Ideal for long and narrow spaces such as hallways, entrances and transitional areas.**

**A linear rug follows the length of the hallway, creating a defined path while maintaining balance within the space. Allow approximately 10–15 cm of visible flooring on each side to frame the rug and preserve the proportions of the room.**

**Position the rug so that it does not interfere with door openings, ensuring a comfortable and functional flow through the space.**

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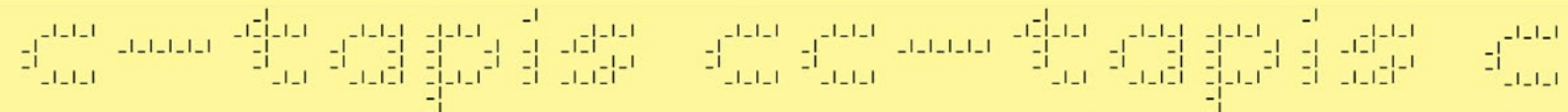
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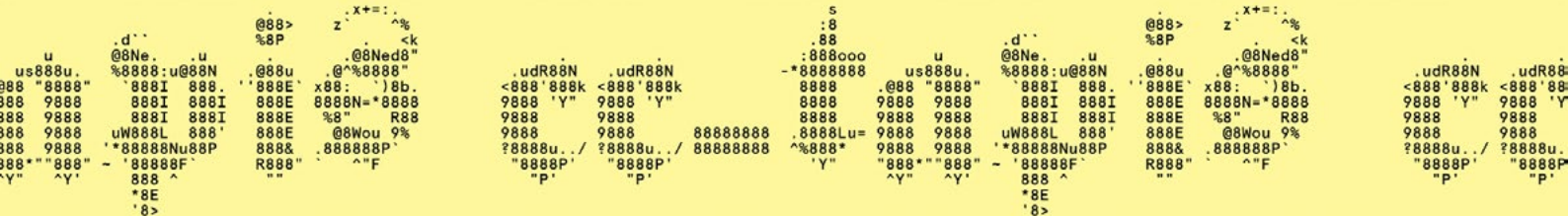
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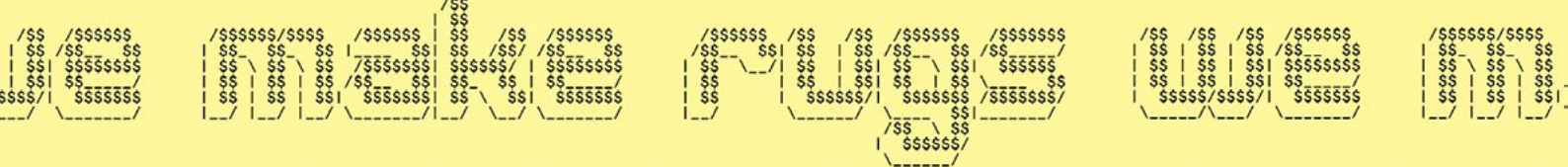
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
